

Government Defeat in Lords on Building Safety (Leaseholder Protections) (England) (Amendment) Regulations 2023

On 21/03/2023 the government had a defeat on a non-fatal motion to regret the Building Safety (Leaseholder Protections) (England) (Amendment) Regulations 2023: To regret that the government is not publishing data on the number of landlords who have benefitted from an error in the regulations and is not seeking to identify or advise affected leaseholders to appeal.

This was defeat number 25 in the parliamentary session.
