

Government Defeat in Lords on Digital Markets, Competition and Consumers Bill

Monday 11/03/2024

On 11/03/2024 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Digital Markets, Competition and Consumers Bill: To change the conditions for the Competition and Markets Authority imposing conduct requirements from cases where it is proportionate to cases where it is appropriate, in order to reduce the risk of extend legal contestation as a means of obfuscation.

This was defeat number 17 in the parliamentary session.
