

Government Defeat in Lords on Digital Markets, Competition and Consumers Bill

On 11/03/2024 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Digital Markets, Competition and Consumers Bill: To narrow the ability of bigger platforms to claim their anti-competitive behaviour presents countervailing benefits.

This was defeat number 18 in the parliamentary session.
