

Government Defeat in Lords on Digital Markets, Competition and Consumers Bill

Monday 11/03/2024

On 11/03/2024 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Digital Markets, Competition and Consumers Bill: To reinstate judicial review principles as the means by which appeals against penalty decisions are heard, rather than such decisions being determined on the merits.

This was defeat number 19 in the parliamentary session.
