# Government Defeat in Lords on Digital Markets, Competition and Consumers Bill

# Monday 11/03/2024

On 11/03/2024 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Digital Markets, Competition and Consumers Bill: To require the Secretary of State to respond within 40 days to draft guidance from the CMA on how it will exercise its functions under the Act.

This was defeat number 20 in the parliamentary session.
