

Government Defeat in Lords on Digital Markets, Competition and Consumers Bill

Wednesday 13/03/2024

On 13/03/2024 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Digital Markets, Competition and Consumers Bill: To add a new clause imposing requirements on secondary tickets sites regarding proof of purchase, ticket number limits and the provision of information.

This was defeat number 21 in the parliamentary session.
