

Government Defeat in Lords on Economic Crime and Corporate Transparency Bill

Tuesday 27/06/2023

On 27/06/2023 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Economic Crime and Corporate Transparency Bill: To remove exemptions for organisations that are not “large organisations” from the failure to prevent regime.

This was defeat number 58 in the parliamentary session.
