

Government Defeat in Lords on Economic Crime and Corporate Transparency Bill

On 27/06/2023 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Economic Crime and Corporate Transparency Bill: To add a new clause adding money laundering to the activity covered by the failure to prevent regime.

This was defeat number 59 in the parliamentary session.
