

Government Defeat in Lords on Economic Crime and Corporate Transparency Bill

Tuesday 20/06/2023

On 20/06/2023 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Economic Crime and Corporate Transparency Bill: To add a new clause requiring a person or firm holding shares to declare if they are doing so as a nominee and if so on whose behalf when declaring information in the register of members for a company.

This was defeat number 51 in the parliamentary session.
