

Government Defeat in Lords on Economic Crime and Corporate Transparency Bill

Tuesday 20/06/2023

On 20/06/2023 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Economic Crime and Corporate Transparency Bill: To add a new clause to require that the register of overseas entities be updated within 14 days of an entity becoming aware of any changes.

This was defeat number 52 in the parliamentary session.
