

Government Defeat in Lords on Economic Crime and Corporate Transparency Bill

On 20/06/2023 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Economic Crime and Corporate Transparency Bill: To remove protected trusts information from the list of materials unavailable for public inspection.

This was defeat number 53 in the parliamentary session.
