

# Government Defeat in Lords on Economic Crime and Corporate Transparency Bill

Wednesday 18/10/2023

On 18/10/2023 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Economic Crime and Corporate Transparency Bill: To insist (x2) on removing the exemption for organisations that are not “large organisations” from the failure to prevent regime.

This was defeat number 125 in the parliamentary session.
