

Government Defeat in Lords on Economic Crime and Corporate Transparency Bill

Wednesday 18/10/2023

On 18/10/2023 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Economic Crime and Corporate Transparency Bill: To insist (x2) on adding a new clause to extend the cost cap for civil recovery cases beyond Unexplained Wealth Orders.

This was defeat number 126 in the parliamentary session.
