# Government Defeat in Lords on Economic Crime and Corporate Transparency Bill

## Monday 11/09/2023

On 11/09/2023 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Economic Crime and Corporate Transparency Bill: To insist on removing the exemption for organisations that are not "large organisations" from the failure to prevent regime.

This was defeat number 109 in the parliamentary session.
