# Government Defeat in Lords on Electoral Commission Strategy and Policy Statement

# Tuesday 06/02/2024

On 06/02/2024 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Electoral Commission Strategy and Policy Statement: To regret that the Strategy and Policy Statement has been laid despite concerns raised during the consultation process including the finding that it is inconsistent with the Commission's role as an independent regulator (non-fatal motion).

This was defeat number 6 in the parliamentary session.
