

Government Defeat in Lords on Energy Bill [HL]

On 17/04/2023 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Energy Bill [HL]: To add a new clause to add a requirement to have regard for the UK's net zero emissions target into Ofgem's general duties.

This was defeat number 30 in the parliamentary session.
