

Government Defeat in Lords on Energy Bill [HL]

On 28/03/2023 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Energy Bill [HL]: To remove the power of the Secretary of State to impose a hydrogen levy on gas and electricity suppliers.

This was defeat number 27 in the parliamentary session.
