

Government Defeat in Lords on Energy Bill [HL]

On 17/04/2023 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Energy Bill [HL]: To add a new clause imposing a duty on the Secretary of State to bring forward a plan within six months of the passage of the act for low carbon heat, energy efficient buildings and higher standards on new homes.

This was defeat number 28 in the parliamentary session.
