

Government Defeat in Lords on Financial Services and Markets Bill

Tuesday 13/06/2023

On 13/06/2023 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Financial Services and Markets Bill: To add a new clause prohibiting regulated activity that supports commercial activity in relation to a forest risk commodity or a product derived from a forest risk commodity unless relevant local laws are complied with.

This was defeat number 47 in the parliamentary session.
