

# Government Defeat in Lords on Illegal Migration Bill

Wednesday 12/07/2023

On 12/07/2023 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Illegal Migration Bill: To insist on replacing a clause in order to ensure the Act will not require any act or omission that would conflict with key international obligations.

This was defeat number 89 in the parliamentary session.
