

Government Defeat in Lords on Illegal Migration Bill

On 12/07/2023 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Illegal Migration Bill: To insist on adding a new clause to prevent LGBT people being removed to countries where they have a well-founded fear of persecution.

This was defeat number 91 in the parliamentary session.
