Government Defeat in Lords on Illegal Migration Bill

On 12/07/2023 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Illegal Migration Bill: To insist with revision on a limit of 72 hours (initially amended to 24 hours) for the detention of unaccompanied children.

This was defeat number 92 in the parliamentary session.
