## Government Defeat in Lords on Illegal Migration Bill

## Wednesday 12/07/2023

On 12/07/2023 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Illegal Migration Bill: To insist on exempting people who have been unlawfully exploited in the United Kingdom from removal during the statutory recovery period for potential victims of slavery or human trafficking.

This was defeat number 94 in the parliamentary session.
