

Government Defeat in Lords on Illegal Migration Bill

Wednesday 12/07/2023

On 12/07/2023 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Illegal Migration Bill: To insist on adding a new clause to give the National Crime Agency a legal responsibility for tackling organised crime across the Channel and to maintain a specific unit for this purpose.

This was defeat number 96 in the parliamentary session.
