# Government Defeat in Lords on Illegal Migration Bill

## Wednesday 12/07/2023

On 12/07/2023 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Illegal Migration Bill: To insist on adding a new clause requiring the Secretary of State to have a ten-year strategy for collaborating internationally to tackle refugee crises affecting migration by irregular routes and human trafficking.

This was defeat number 97 in the parliamentary session.
