

Government Defeat in Lords on Illegal Migration Bill

Wednesday 28/06/2023

On 28/06/2023 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Illegal Migration Bill: To ensure that potential and recognised victims of trafficking will not be detained or removed before they get the opportunity to submit an application to the Modern Slavery National Referral Mechanism.

This was defeat number 63 in the parliamentary session.
