

Government Defeat in Lords on Illegal Migration Bill

On 03/07/2023 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Illegal Migration Bill: To replace a clause in order to remove the time limit for serious harm suspensive claims and to remove examples of harms specified as not serious harms for the purposes of serious harm suspensive claims.

This was defeat number 74 in the parliamentary session.
