

Government Defeat in Lords on Illegal Migration Bill

On 28/06/2023 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Illegal Migration Bill: To make asylum and human rights claims admissible from unaccompanied children, who are exempted from the duty to remove.

This was defeat number 64 in the parliamentary session.
