

# Government Defeat in Lords on Illegal Migration Bill

Monday 03/07/2023

On 03/07/2023 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Illegal Migration Bill: To require the Secretary of State to consider a protection or human rights claim if the applicant has not been removed from the UK within six months of being deemed inadmissible and to disapply other provisions of the Act at this point.

This was defeat number 65 in the parliamentary session.
