

Government Defeat in Lords on Illegal Migration Bill

On 03/07/2023 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Illegal Migration Bill: To remove a clause that would have prohibited courts or tribunals from granting interim remedies that prevent or delay the removal of persons from the United Kingdom.

This was defeat number 22 in the parliamentary session.
