

Government Defeat in Lords on Illegal Migration Bill

On 05/07/2023 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Illegal Migration Bill: To reinstate the right of appeal against age assessments in respect of putative children whom there is a duty to remove under the Act.

This was defeat number 77 in the parliamentary session.
