

Government Defeat in Lords on Illegal Migration Bill

On 05/07/2023 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Illegal Migration Bill: To allow appeals for age of assessment to grant relief in cases where the previous decision was wrong or misinformed on a matter of fact, not just of law.

This was defeat number 78 in the parliamentary session.
