Government Defeat in Lords on Illegal Migration Bill Monday 03/07/2023

On 03/07/2023 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Illegal Migration Bill: To add a new clause to prevent LGBT people being removed to countries where they have a well-founded fear of persecution; or to a country which is subject to proceedings under Article 7 of the Treaty on European Union.

This was defeat number 66 in the parliamentary session.
