

Government Defeat in Lords on Illegal Migration Bill

On 28/06/2023 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Illegal Migration Bill: To replace a clause in order to ensure the Act will not require any act or omission that would conflict with key international obligations.

This was defeat number 61 in the parliamentary session.
