

Government Defeat in Lords on Illegal Migration Bill

On 03/07/2023 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Illegal Migration Bill: To retain the existing limit of 24 hours for the detention of unaccompanied children.

This was defeat number 67 in the parliamentary session.
