

Government Defeat in Lords on Illegal Migration Bill

On 03/07/2023 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Illegal Migration Bill: To retain the existing limit of 72 hours (or one week with ministerial approval) for the detention of children.

This was defeat number 68 in the parliamentary session.
