

Government Defeat in Lords on Illegal Migration Bill

On 28/06/2023 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Illegal Migration Bill: To ensure the duty to deport does not apply retrospectively to those who entered the United Kingdom before the Act comes into force.

This was defeat number 62 in the parliamentary session.
