

# Government Defeat in Lords on Illegal Migration Bill

On 03/07/2023 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Illegal Migration Bill: Paving amendment to confirm the that the lawfulness of immigration detention remains subject to the principles established in the common law, including the Hardial Singh principles that limit detention powers.

This was defeat number 70 in the parliamentary session.
