

# Government Defeat in Lords on Illegal Migration Bill

Monday 03/07/2023

On 03/07/2023 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Illegal Migration Bill: To limit the Secretary of State's power to transfer a child out of local authority care by restricting this to cases where it is necessary to safeguard and promote the welfare of the child.

This was defeat number 71 in the parliamentary session.
