

Government Defeat in Lords on Illegal Migration Bill

On 03/07/2023 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Illegal Migration Bill: To require the Secretary of State to make provision by regulation about when it is necessary for a person to be present in the United Kingdom to cooperate with an investigation or criminal proceedings in relation to slavery or human trafficking.

This was defeat number 73 in the parliamentary session.
