

Government Defeat in Lords on Immigration (Age Assessments) Regulations 2023

Monday 27/11/2023

On 27/11/2023 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Immigration (Age Assessments) Regulations 2023: To regret that the government has brought forward regulations for x-ray age verification tests that are premature as the policy is still under development and insufficient information about free consent and impact have been provided (non-fatal motion).

This was defeat number 2 in the parliamentary session.
