

Government Defeat in Lords on Levelling-up and Regeneration Bill

On 04/09/2023 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Levelling-up and Regeneration Bill: To add a new clause requiring the Secretary of State to engage with local authorities to devise strategies to reduce the number of high street financial services becoming vacant premises.

This was defeat number 103 in the parliamentary session.
