

Government Defeat in Lords on Levelling-up and Regeneration Bill

On 04/09/2023 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Levelling-up and Regeneration Bill: To stipulate the process for the Secretary of State to designate and review a national development management policy including minimum public consultation requirements and a process of parliamentary scrutiny.

This was defeat number 104 in the parliamentary session.
