

Government Defeat in Lords on Levelling-up and Regeneration Bill

On 04/09/2023 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Levelling-up and Regeneration Bill: To add a new clause requiring the Secretary of State and relevant planning authorities to have special regard to the mitigation of, and adaptation to, climate change with respect to national policy, local plan-making and planning decisions.

This was defeat number 105 in the parliamentary session.
