

Government Defeat in Lords on Levelling-up and Regeneration Bill

On 04/09/2023 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Levelling-up and Regeneration Bill: To add a new clause requiring the Secretary of State to promote a comprehensive regulatory framework for planning and the built environment to secure the physical, mental and social health and well-being of the people of England.

This was defeat number 106 in the parliamentary session.
