

Government Defeat in Lords on Levelling-up and Regeneration Bill

On 06/09/2023 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Levelling-up and Regeneration Bill: To require local plans to identify local housing needs and make provisions for sufficient social rent housing and to eliminate homelessness within a reasonable time period.

This was defeat number 108 in the parliamentary session.
