

Government Defeat in Lords on Levelling-up and Regeneration Bill

On 11/07/2023 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Levelling-up and Regeneration Bill: To require that the levelling-up missions include a mission to reduce the proportion of children living in poverty.

This was defeat number 84 in the parliamentary session.
