

Government Defeat in Lords on Levelling-up and Regeneration Bill

On 13/07/2023 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Levelling-up and Regeneration Bill: To add a new clause allowing local authorities to meet virtually.

This was defeat number 101 in the parliamentary session.
