

# Government Defeat in Lords on Levelling-up and Regeneration Bill

Wednesday 13/09/2023

On 13/09/2023 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Levelling-up and Regeneration Bill: To add a new clause allowing local authorities to set the fees for planning applications so that the cost of determining an application is reflected by the fee charged.

This was defeat number 116 in the parliamentary session.
