

Government Defeat in Lords on Levelling-up and Regeneration Bill

Wednesday 13/09/2023

On 13/09/2023 the government had a defeat in the House of Lords on an amendment to the Levelling-up and Regeneration Bill: To reject a government amendment that would have added a new clause giving the Secretary of State powers to make regulations disapplying or modifying regulations relating to nutrients in water in regard to planning and development in England.

This was defeat number 117 in the parliamentary session.
